**On Saturday 08-22-09 a skimmer was placed on the ATM at Regions Bank in Dolphin Village. The skimmer reads your credit/debit card number and the suspect puts a camera on the ATM to capture your pin number. The skimmer was left in place for several hours and numerous victims.**

**Be vigilant when using an ATM. The most commonly reported clue there is a skimmer in place is difficulty inserting or having to reinsert the card several times. The bad guys will generally be within eyeshot of the ATM in a SUV or minivan.**
